They are currently making a big impression on the national and international music scene with appearances on a number of TV and Radio shows. Their new single 'Don't It Feel Good' is currently play listed on RTE Radio 1. Earlier this summer they had the honour of performing at Arás an Uachtaráin by invitation of President Michael D Higgins. They performed the title song at the 2013 Rose of Tralee International Festival before a TV audience of 1.2 million. They have also made appearances on RTE's 'Up For The Match' 2011, the Derek Mooney Show and the John Murray Show on Radio 1. They have toured extensively in the U.S. and the UK, and have a further U.S. tour planned for March 2017. In 2012 they had the honour of singing in Croke Park at the All-Ireland Hurling Final replay between Kilkenny and Galway. They have also performed at the GAA Ladies All-Star Awards and the National GAA Handball Awards.
