

GUIDELINES FOR THE “MISS IRELAND” PAGEANT CONTESTANTS

Each contestant is required to have some Irish heritage.

Each contestant will be judged in the following categories:

General Appearance
Poise
***** Expression of your Irish Heritage *****
Question

**** Each contestant must tell a poem, story, or give a speech. Your poem, story, or speech, should take approximately 1 ½ to 2 minutes and *must* have an Irish theme. This is the time to express your Irish heritage & what it means to you. *****

IF SELECTED “MISS IRELAND”

- Miss Ireland shall be accompanied by her traveling companion or parent at all appearances. (The traveling companion will be a member of the Pageant Committee).
- Miss Ireland **MUST** make appearances at the Irish Festival, the Irish Craft Show, and next year’s Miss Ireland Pageant.
- Miss Ireland or a member of her court must be available for other appearances in the Jefferson County area as designated by the Pageant Committee. (Dates and time will be made available in advance).
- Miss Ireland may only hold one title at a time. If Miss Ireland chooses to enter & wins any other pageant, the scholarship monies will be prorated equal to the time spent as Miss Ireland.
- Miss Ireland will not hold press/media conferences without a Committee member present.

Please remember that this is not a beauty pageant. While only one contestant will be selected as “Miss Ireland”, the Committee would like each contestant to have a great time and to look at this event as a good experience and a way to make new friends.

MISS IRELAND PAGEANT CONSENT FORM

4. I agree that there will be no media/press conferences without a Committee member present.
