WHAT: \$1,500 scholarship(s) will be awarded by the *North Country Goes Green Irish Festival* for students residing in Jefferson, Lewis or St. Lawrence counties who plan on attending an accredited college in the fall. These are one time awards for the upcoming academic year.

SCHOLARSHIP BEING OFFERED FOR STUDENTS ENTERING IN A FIELD OF EDUCATION: In honor of William K. Archer, at least one scholarship will be offered to any student who is planning on becoming an educator.

WHO: Any high school senior pursuing a college degree or are currently enrolled in a college degree program.

REQUIREMENTS: You must be a high school senior or currently enrolled at a college. You must also be accepted into a college degree accredited program starting the fall of the upcoming academic year. You must complete an application form for the scholarship.
